




# **Job Vacancy & Work Scope**

### Role Objective

The Aquarist role support the care, maintenance, and operation of our freshwater aquarium exhibits. This role is crucial to ensuring the health of our aquatic animals and the smooth functioning of our life-support systems.

### Key Tasks and Responsibilities

- Perform daily aquarium care: feeding, water checks, cleaning, and monitoring animal health.
- Conduct water parameter testing (pH, ammonia, nitrite, nitrate, temperature & TDS).
- Carry out tank cleaning, water changes, aquascaping, and general aquarium upkeep.
- Maintain and troubleshoot life-support equipment (pumps, filters, heaters, chillers, lights, aerator).
- Document daily observations, maintenance tasks, and fishes health/ behavioural changes.
- Follow proper quarantine procedures for new or sick animals.
- **Work during Islamic public holidays** as scheduled.
- Act as the **first responder** for emergencies such as equipment failure, water quality issues, power disruptions, and livestock distress.
- Maintain a safe and healthy working area by following all HSE guidelines and policies established by SEL.



#### Skills Required or Preferred

- Experience with aquarium keeping (freshwater and/or marine).
- Understanding of water chemistry, filtration systems, and aquatic animal care.
- Ability to respond calmly and efficiently to emergencies.
- Physically fit and capable of lifting equipment's and water containers (10–20 kg).
- Responsible, observant, and able to manage routine tasks independently.
- Willing to work during Islamic public holidays as per required.
- Strong interest in marine biology, aquaculture, or environmental science is an advantage.
